

Double Vision Garden

Our Double Vision garden is named for the many double daylilies that we grow and enjoy. Our garden has an average of 250-300 daylily cultivars including 120 double daylily cultivars. We usually add and remove about 30 cultivars per year. Most plants are from the 90's with maybe 50 cultivars in the 2000's. We have about 50 daylilies that are mature at 3 to 5 years old with 16 or more fans.



Some of our favorite daylilies that are super growers here in Ohio are: Untamed Glory, Moonlit Masquerade, Wally, Ornamental Focus, Yellow Explosion, Tommy Lee Joiner, Moses Fire, Smugglers Gold, Savanna Debutante, Adopt Me, Dashing Double, and Cluster Muster. Our list of favorites changes each year as plants get older and really start to perform. Some of our favorite hybridizers whose plants do well here are Joiner, Stamile, Gossard, Moldovan, Hanson, Branch and Kropf.

We also grow complementary plants such as Orientpet lilies (10 varieties) up to 7 feet tall, Endless Summer hydrangeas, sedum (15 varieties), a herb garden, a few Knockout and Rugosa roses, Lavender (10 varieties) a shade garden with Ostrich and Cinnamon ferns and hostas, irises, and ten varieties of clematis. Lavenders grow well in our Zone 5 garden and some are shrubs that are two feet or more tall. We also particularly enjoy our Orientpet lilies that bloom in August after many of our daylilies are bloomed out. Some of them are 8 feet tall this year (2007). We are proceeding with a major garden renovation this coming year to add structure (i.e. paths, benches, arbors, and other features) on our third acre lot.



Two of our favorite orientpet lilies are Silk Road and Scheherazade. We also grow Anastasia, Boogie Woogie, Robina, American Spirit, High Stakes and Mother of Pearl. We grow a few oriental lilies, Asiatic lilies and some old favorites such as the Madonna Lily, Tiger Lily and Citronella Lily. It is nice to see these

lilies blooming in June and August before and after the peak daylily blooming season.
