

Kit Walter's Garden

My AHS display garden is situated on a lot 180 feet x 60 feet in the City of Galion, Ohio. Within these small boundaries lie a collector's garden of daylilies consisting of over 500 labeled varieties including Spiders, Unusual Forms, Doubles, and most all flower sizes. Many hybridizers are represented. Nearly 100 Hostas, a small fish pond, perennials, daffodils, and a few shrubs and trees (Tri-Colored Beech, Ginkgo, Dawn Redwood) fill out the remaining area. The Musa Basjoo, a hardy banana plant is joined each year by various tropical or zone denial plants, giving the yard an exotic feel. The garden is located on a hill with plenty of walking paths, a patio or two with tables and chairs, a fish pond, and a pergola type trellis.

Peak bloom for my garden is early to mid July. Please call ahead and set a time if you would like to visit. I will sell plants and will be as generous as possible.
